Please find attached our Ofsted report for their visit on 4th July.

As you may be aware, the current Ofsted Section 8 (short) inspection schedule does not allow for a change in a 'Good' school's grade unless there is a serious safeguarding or behaviour issue. Instead, they write a report detailing the strengths and any areas for improvement of the school. Where the inspector thinks the grade needs to change to 'Requires Improvement' or 'Outstanding', the school would receive a two-day Section 5 (full) inspection within 24 months.

We are extremely pleased with the report, which we feel reflects the school accurately. Whatever press Ofsted receive, we felt the inspection was fair and thorough. The feedback is overwhelmingly positive, with clear references that the approaches we have in place are having a very positive impact on children's learning, behaviour, happiness and attitudes. Lots of what we do is 'Outstanding' and we look forward to this being recognised officially in our next inspection report.

Coupled with our fabulous results across school, we firmly believe that the school is providing an excellent all round education and happy environment for the children and we will continue to keep strengthening this in all we do.
